The CPR was the only North American railroad to use the 2-10-4s for passenger service. The Class T-1c "Selkirks" were semi-streamlined and carried a colorful passenger livery and were used to haul passenger trains over the Rockies. The CPR did not adopt the name "Texas" and chose to call them "Selkirks" for the range of the Rockies that the Railway crossed. #5935 is preserved in Delson, Quebec while the 5931 is in Calgary's Heritage Park.
